Oasis School Food on the First resumes September 2!

We will resume collecting non-perishable food for the Oasis School healthy food pantry on Labor Day weekend Sunday. This benefits Migrant Education students and their families who work in Coachella Valley agriculture, but whose food budgets may not stretch quite enough, especially after spending on new school year supplies. **If you will be away** Labor Day weekend, put non-perishable food items only in the Oasis bin the last Sunday in August. We ask for items from **four categories**: 1) bagged rice or dried pinto beans or corn masa flour like Maseca; 2) canned chicken or tuna or jars of peanut butter; 3) canned fruit, tomatoes, tomato sauce or vegetables; 4) bottled cooking oil.
