Indoor Phase 1 Covid Protocols
April 20, 2021

Requirements for Church-Sponsored Indoor Gatherings:

- *This applies to all indoor Church-sponsored activities, whether on UUCOD premises or elsewhere. This does not apply to Sunday Worship Services.*
- Each group should designate a Safety Coordinator and maintain contact tracing information.
- Everyone entering the building must show proof of vaccination (defined as two weeks after the final vaccination).
- If anyone in the group requests, then all attendees will wear masks or maintain distance.

Guidance for Group Leaders

- The Board is *allowing* indoor activities, not necessarily *encouraging* them. The group leader needs to consult with the entire group membership and see what best meets the needs of the group, with a serious concern of not excluding people nor making anyone feel unsafe.
- The Group Leader should discuss the wearing of masks and/or distancing before the event to establish comfort for everyone and eliminate surprises.

Consideration for Employees:

- UUCOD is committed to providing a safe working environment. A separate discussion and agreement is needed to cover employees on-site.

Requirements for Renters:

- The requirements for renters are identical to those for UUCOD-sponsored activities.

Food service and consumption:

- No specific limitations are made regarding food (since everyone is fully vaccinated)

Singing:

- Regardless of the 100% fully vaccinated requirement, extra precautions apply to singing to limit airborne contamination of the facility.
- Singing is limited to the sanctuary, which has a separate air condition system. The interior doors to the sanctuary shall remain closed.
- After any singing activity the air conditioning system will run long enough to perform one full air exchange (generally overnight) before the sanctuary is to be used by another group.
