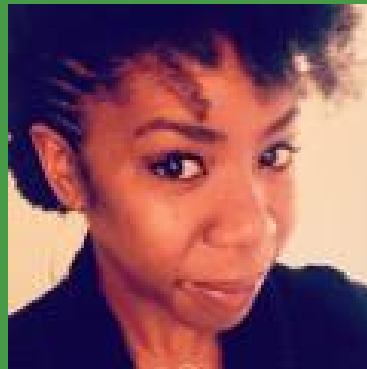

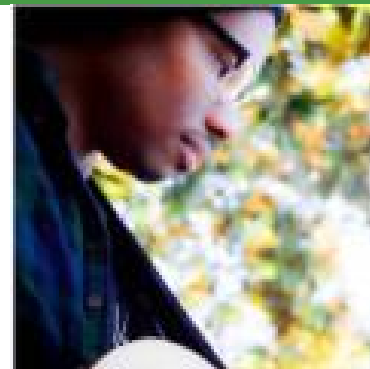

Two Ways to Support Safe Schools Desert Cities for May's Share the Plate

Safe Schools Desert Cities will be our Share the Plate recipient on Sunday, May 16.

They work directly with area schools to empower LGBT+ youth, allies, and advisors through education, guidance, and opportunities for self-expression.

They work with over 30 GSAs (Gay Straight Alliances) in high schools and middle schools in the Coachella Valley and the surrounding area, including Banning, Beaumont, Yucca Valley and Twenty-nine Palms. These campus-based organizations provide safe environments for students to explore their sexuality and their gender identification.

Safe Schools Desert Cities also provides educational and social activities including the annual Rainbow Youth Summit and Pride Prom as well as the "Youth Zone" during the Greater Palm Springs Pride Festival and Pride Parade.

Due to COVID restrictions, in-person events were canceled this school year. They look forward to sponsoring these events again beginning with the Greater Palm Springs Pride Festival and Parade in November 2021.

UUCOD BOARD UPDATE ON COVID PROTOCOLS

UUCOD Indoor Phase 1 Covid Protocols April 20, 2021 Requirements for Church-Sponsored Indoor Gatherings:

This applies to all indoor Church-sponsored activities, whether on UUCOD premises or elsewhere. This does not apply to Sunday Worship Services.

- Each group should designate a Safety Coordinator and maintain contact tracing information.
- Everyone entering the building must show proof of vaccination (defined as two weeks after the final vaccination). In reaching this policy, the Board deliberated the exclusion of people who could not safely attend without knowledge that everyone is vaccinated versus the exclusion of people who are unvaccinated.
- If anyone in the group requests, then all attendees will wear masks or maintain distance.

Guidance

- The Board is allowing indoor activities, not necessarily encouraging them.
- The Group leader needs to consult with the entire group membership and see what best meets the needs of the group, with a serious concern of not excluding people

nor making anyone feel unsafe.

- The Group Leader should discuss the wearing of masks and/or distancing before the event to establish comfort for everyone and eliminate surprises.

Details

- These protocols apply equally to renters.
- Facilities will follow CDC procedures for re-opening a building that has been closed.
