PATIO TABLES

It is the Policy of the Unitarian Universalist Church of the Desert:

1. The purpose of having information tables on the patio is to provide opportunities for members and friends of the congregation, and their children, to engage with each other in programs and activities of the church. The tables vary throughout the year reflecting seasonal changes and include administrative efforts (e.g. Stewardship), fund raising events, information about community non-profits with which we have ongoing involvement, etc. The tables are hosted by various standing and ad hoc committees, or other church members as approved by the Minister or the Board President.
2. Examples of permitted uses are:
 - Organizations with whom we share the plate
 - Non-Profit organizations with whom the Social Justice Committee has “partnered”
 - Organizations that have assisted UUCOD in its activities
Members’ or Friends’ Children or Grandchildren selling Girl Scout Cookies
