Indoor Phase 1 Covid Protocols
Updated June 24, 2021

Requirements for Church-Sponsored Indoor Gatherings:

- *This applies to all indoor Church-sponsored activities, whether on UUCOD premises or elsewhere. This allows only activities with attendees drawn from known groups, not open to the general public. This does not yet apply to general attendance at Sunday Worship.*
- Each group should designate a Safety Coordinator and maintain contact tracing information.
- Everyone entering the building must be fully vaccinated (defined as two weeks after the final vaccination).
- If anyone in the group requests, then all attendees will wear masks or maintain distance.

Guidance for Group Leaders

- The Board is *allowing* indoor activities, not necessarily *encouraging* them. The group leader needs to consult with the entire group membership and see what best meets the needs of the group, with a serious concern of not excluding people nor making anyone feel unsafe.
- The Group Leader should discuss the wearing of masks and/or distancing before the event to establish comfort for everyone and eliminate surprises.

Requirements for Renters:

- The requirements for renters are identical to those for UUCOD sponsored activities.

Food service and consumption:

- No specific limitations are made regarding food (since everyone is fully vaccinated)

Singing:

- We advise 3 feet spacing between family groups, which follows the UUA Guidance for singing among fully vaccinated people.
